

**Frank-Martin Haecker, MD, FEAPU**, is currently Professor of Pediatric Surgery and Co-Head of the Department of Pediatric Surgery at the University Children's Hospital Basel (UKBB), Switzerland.

He attended Medical School at the University of Bochum (RUB) and the University of Tuebingen, Germany, where he received his medical degree in 1990. He served as a junior staff member at the Department of Pediatric Surgery at the University Hospital of Tuebingen and at the Department of General Surgery at the Hospital of Baden-Baden (Germany).

Then he became Attending Surgeon at the Department of Pediatric Surgery at the UKBB in Basel (Switzerland) from 2000-2007. In 2008 he became an Assistant Professor of Pediatric Surgery at the University of Basel. Since 2014 he is Professor of Pediatric Surgery. He is now a senior staff member in the Department of Pediatric Surgery at the UKBB.

Professor Haecker is particularly interested in conservative and surgical treatment of chest wall deformities as well as in pediatric urology. He serves as the head of both the Pectus Program and the Department of Pediatric Urology at the UKBB.

Since 2014, he became senior consultant at the Department of Pediatric Surgery at the University Hospital of Freiburg (Germany).

Professor Haecker is a member of several national and international professional societies. He is member of the executive committee of the CWIG (Chest Wall International Group).
