

Mustafa Yuksel was born in Ankara, Turkey in 1953. He graduated from the Ankara University Medical Faculty in 1977. He had his postdoctoral training at the Ankara Ataturk Thoracic Diseases and Thoracic Surgery Center to become a thoracic and cardiovascular surgeon. Until 1990 he worked at the Heybeliada Thoracic Diseases and Thoracic Surgery Center as a vice chief. In 1991 he became an assistant professor at the Marmara University Medical Faculty, Department of Thoracic Surgery. He worked together with Doctor Peter Goldstraw at the Royal Brompton National Heart-Lung Hospital in London, UK for one year from 1991 to 1992. He returned to Marmara University to become the head of department. He became an associate professor in 1994, and a professor in 1999. Having written many articles and chapters in the field, Doctor Yuksel has been working at the Marmara University Medical Faculty as the Head of Thoracic Surgery Department then on. Prof. Yuksel has become the President of the Turkish Thoracic Surgery Society in November 2012. He is also the founding member and the previous President of the Chest Wall International Group (CWIG).
